After more than a year with no opportunities to join a congress with speakers presenting to a live audience the progress that Ireland and the UK are making in combating Covid19 means that meeting together in Belfast in September is now a reality. Since registration opened over 50% of the delegates have indicated that they intend to travel to Belfast and this includes most of our keynote speakers and people who have already submitted presentations. The option of joining the congress online also remains and after you register it will be easy to switch from online to in person and vice versa nearer the congress.

The ICC in Belfast has the technology to run a hybrid congress that will join together those people attending in person and online in a live event. Everyone who registers for the full congress will also benefit from access to over 120 hours of the recorded programme, including all the keynote speakers. This means that even after the congress ends it will continue to contribute to your continuing professional development
